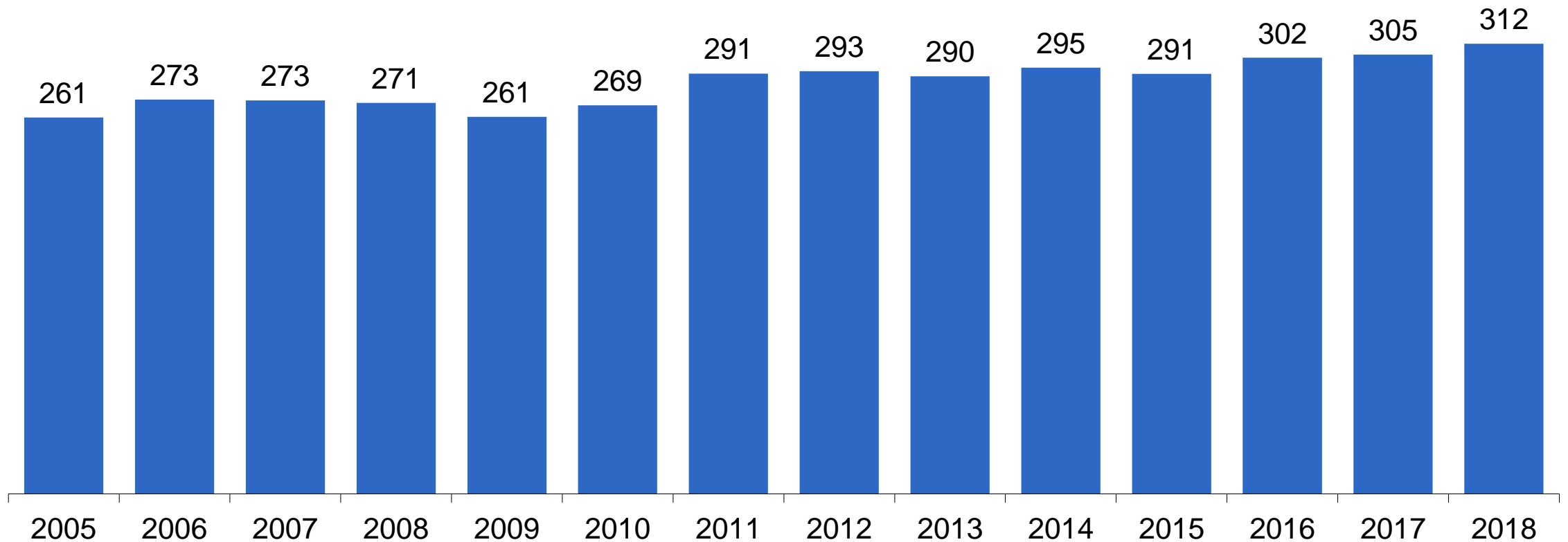

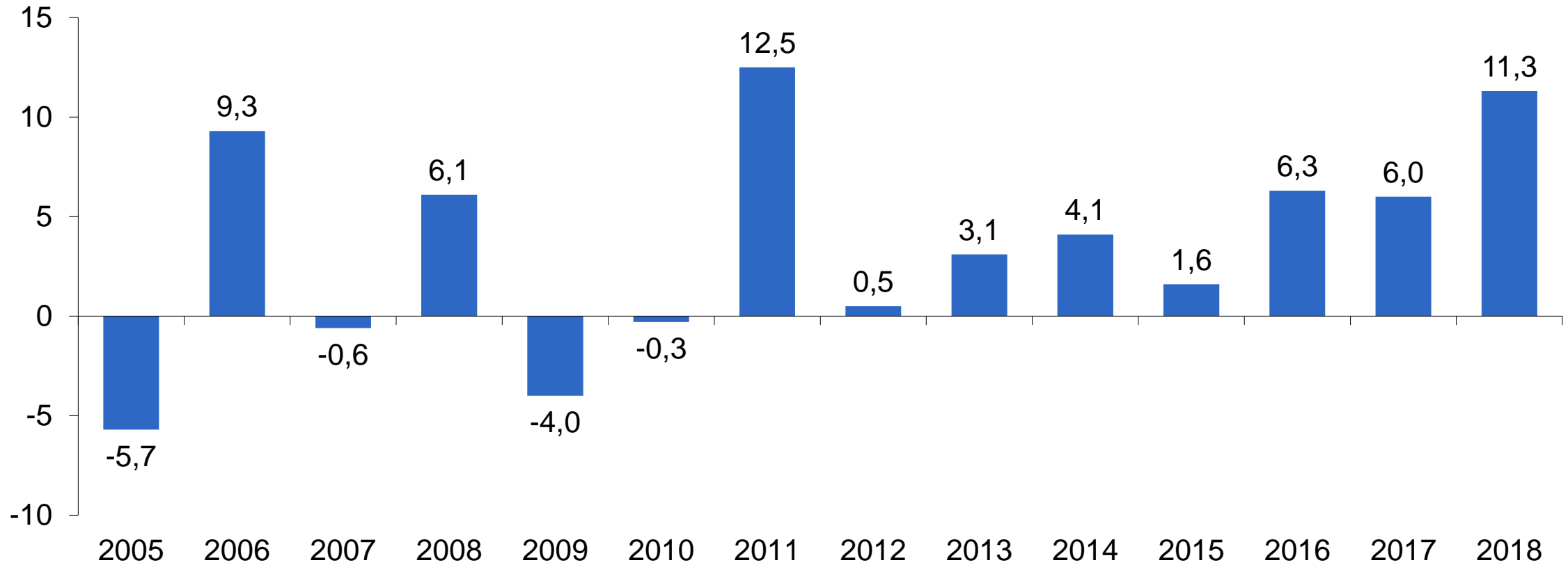

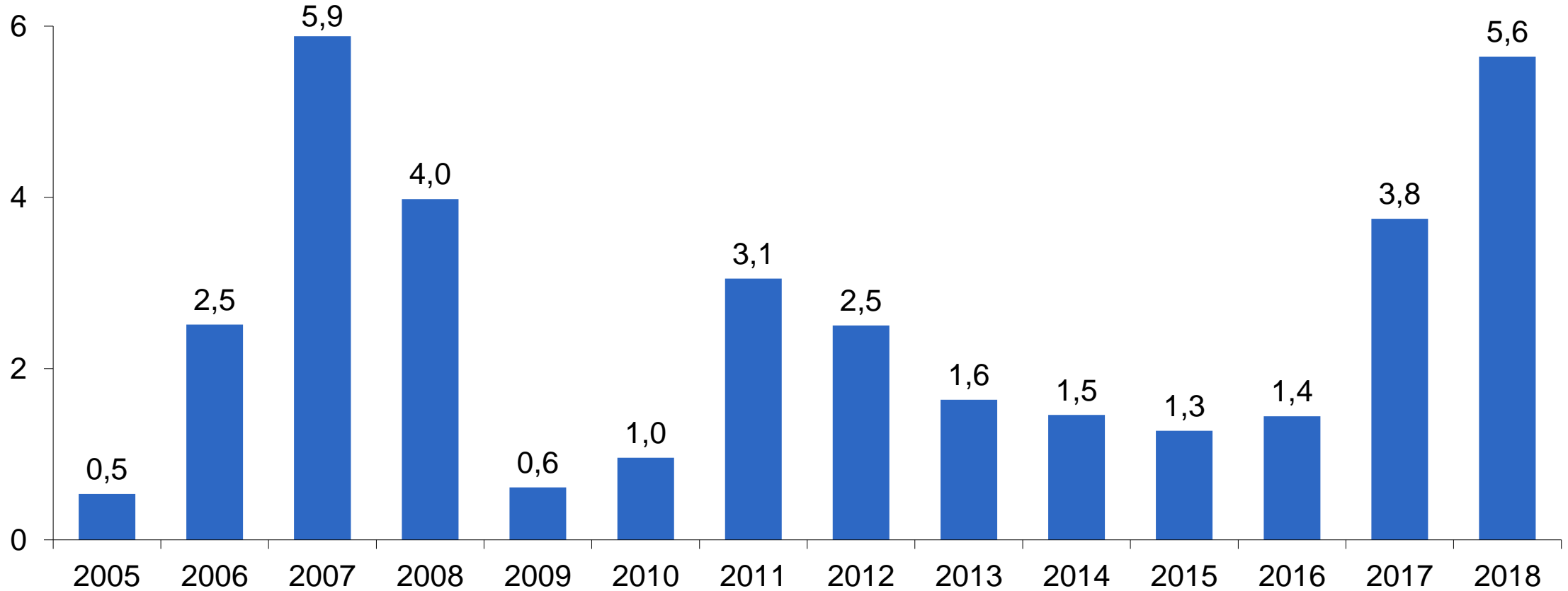
against previous year, current prices

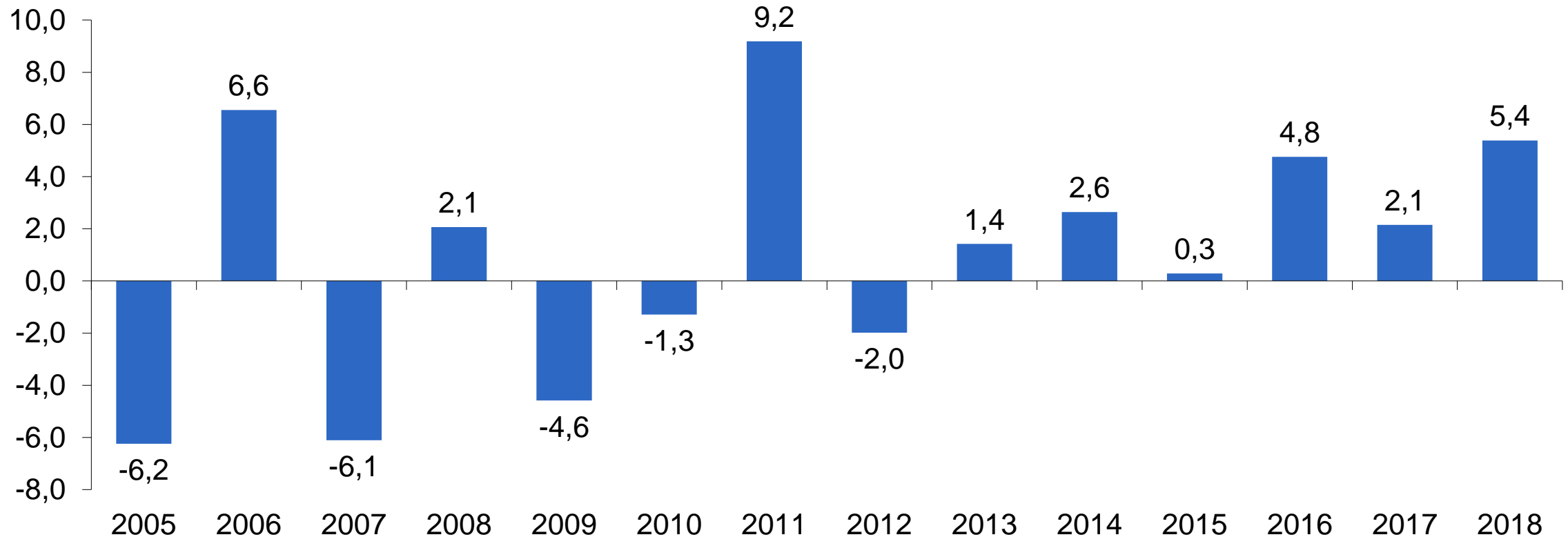
against previous year, per cent

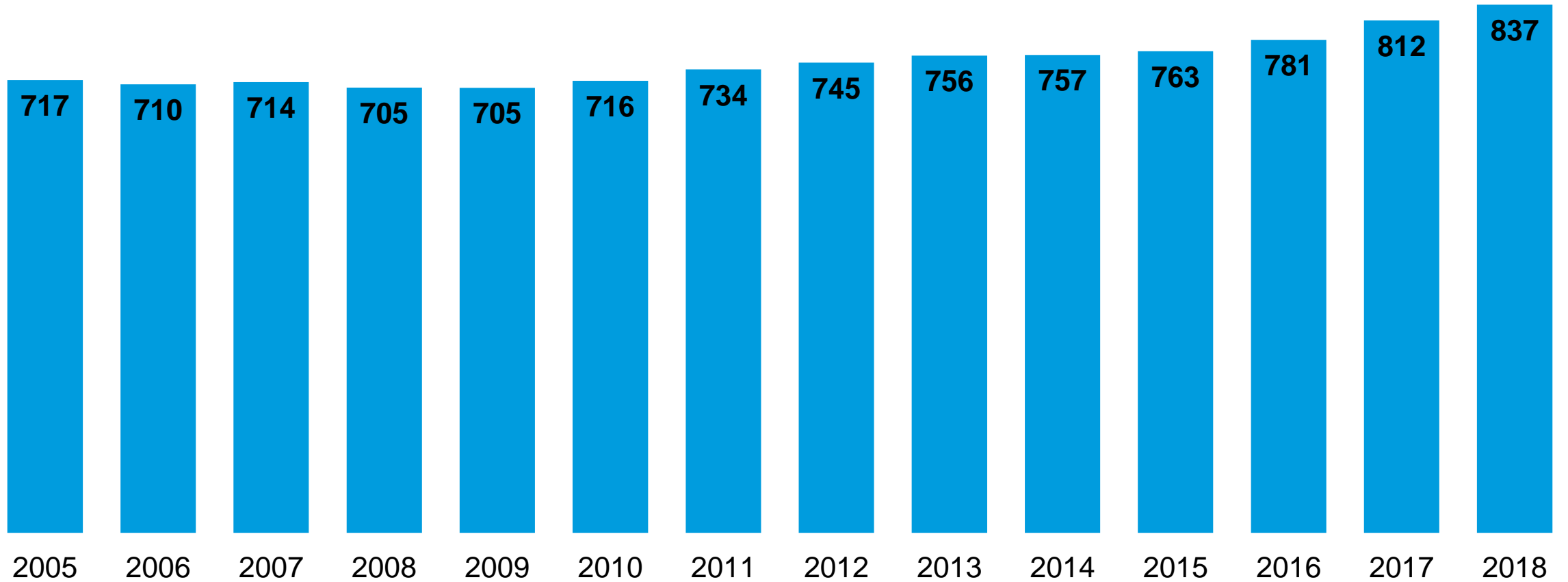

against previous year, constant prices, per cent

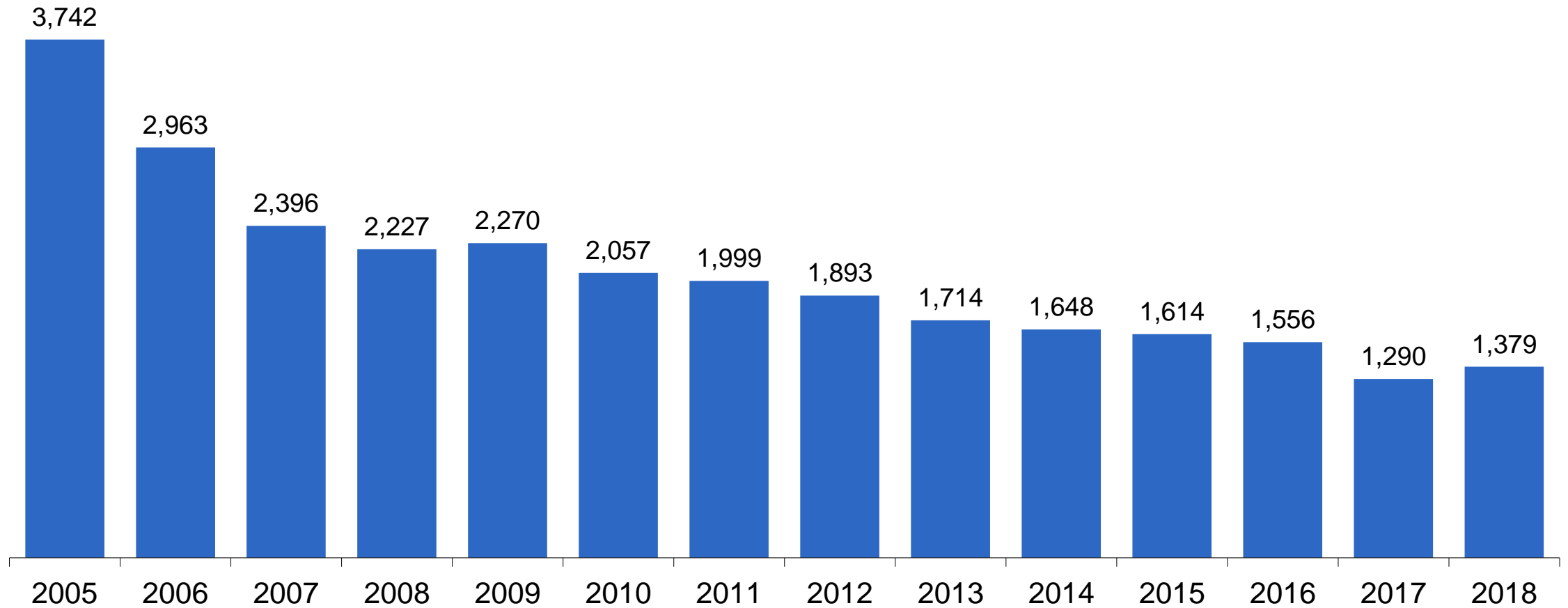


## Employees in the Construction Industry

## Insolvencies in the Construction Industry

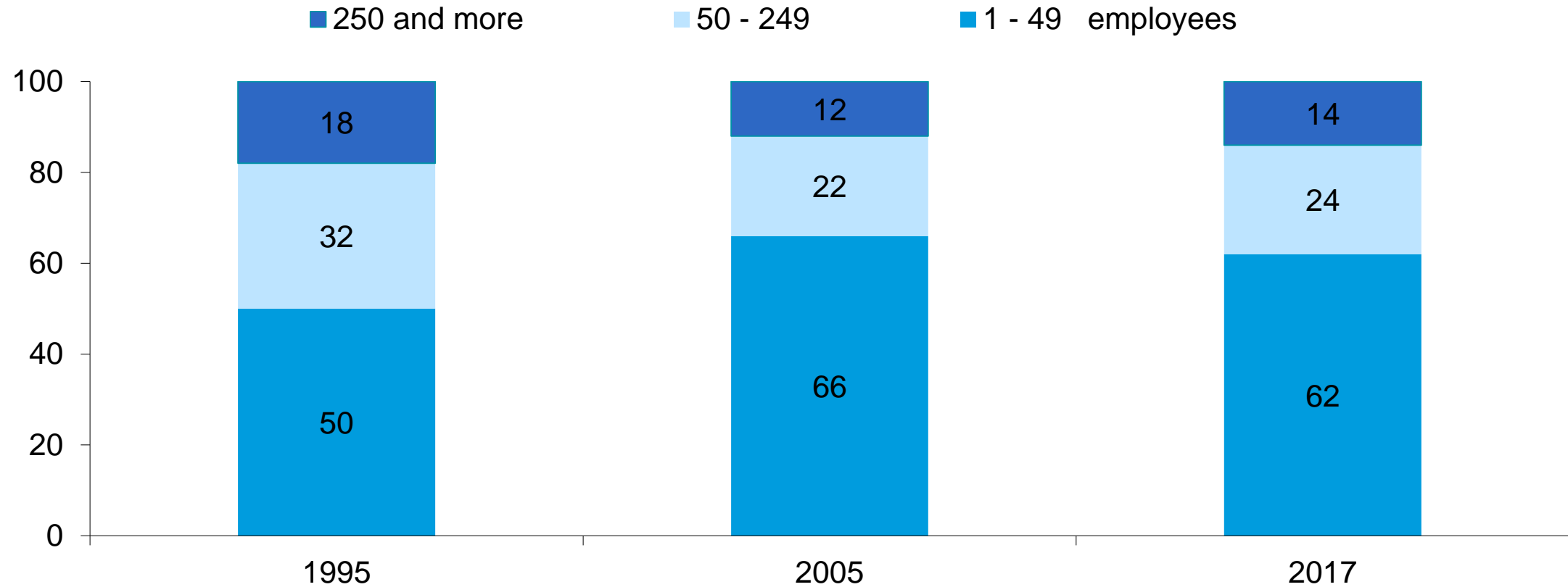

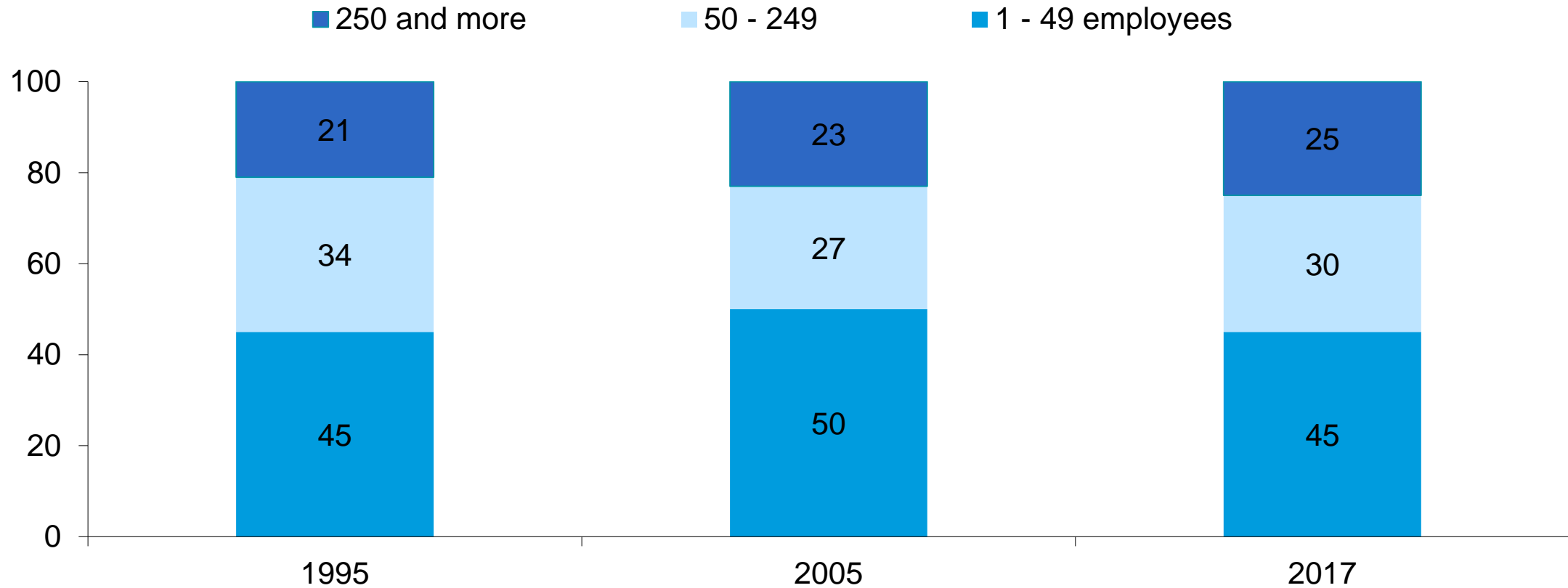
# Employment Structure in the Construction Industry

Turnover according to the size of the company, per cent



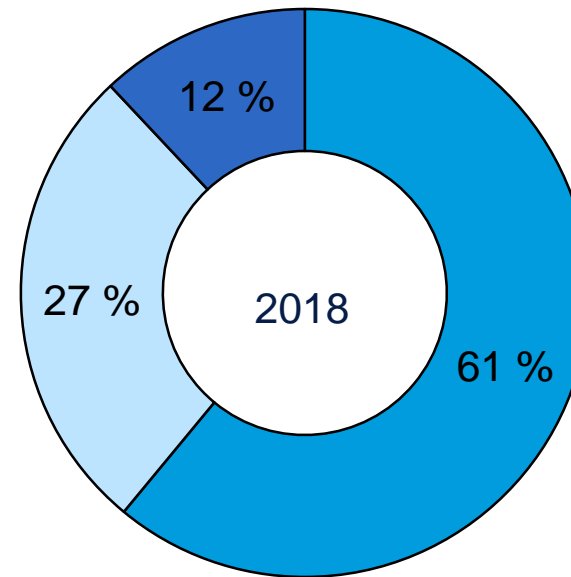
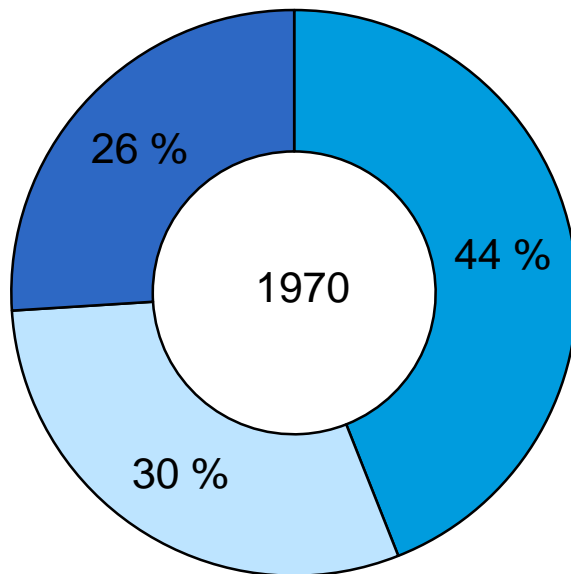

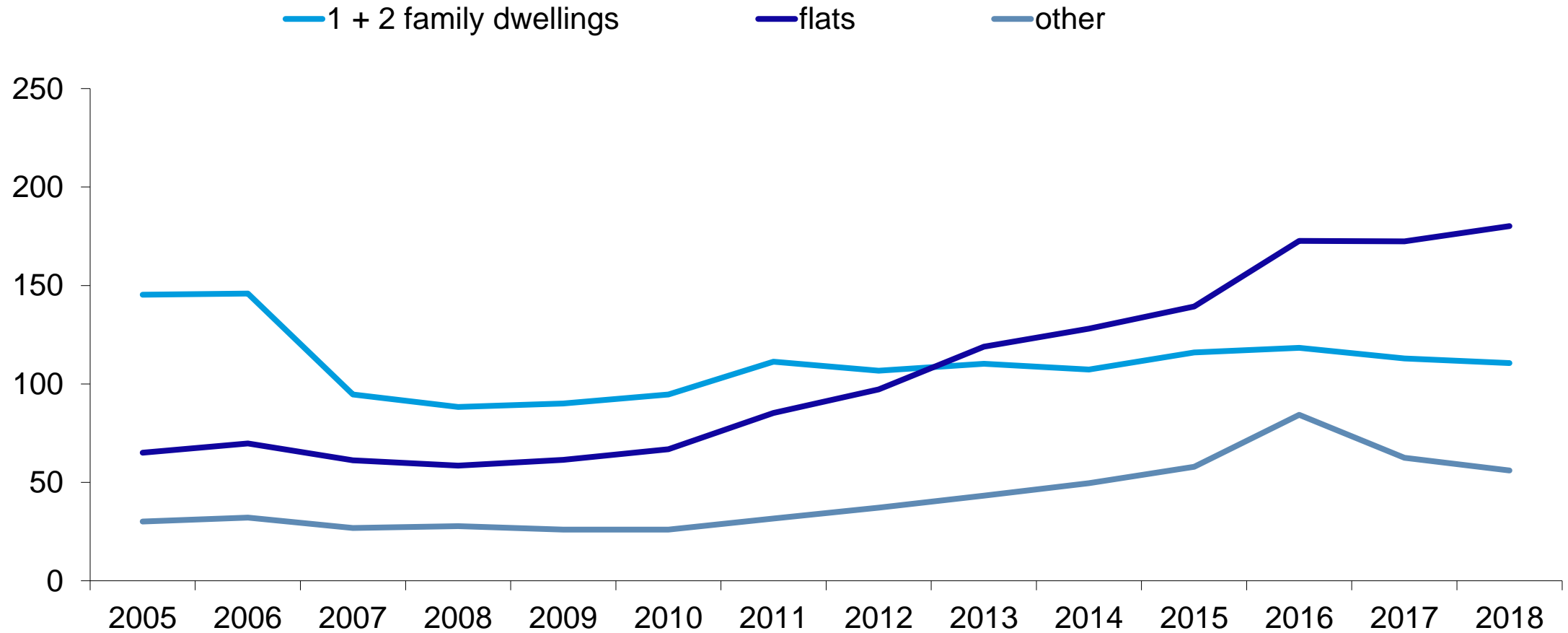

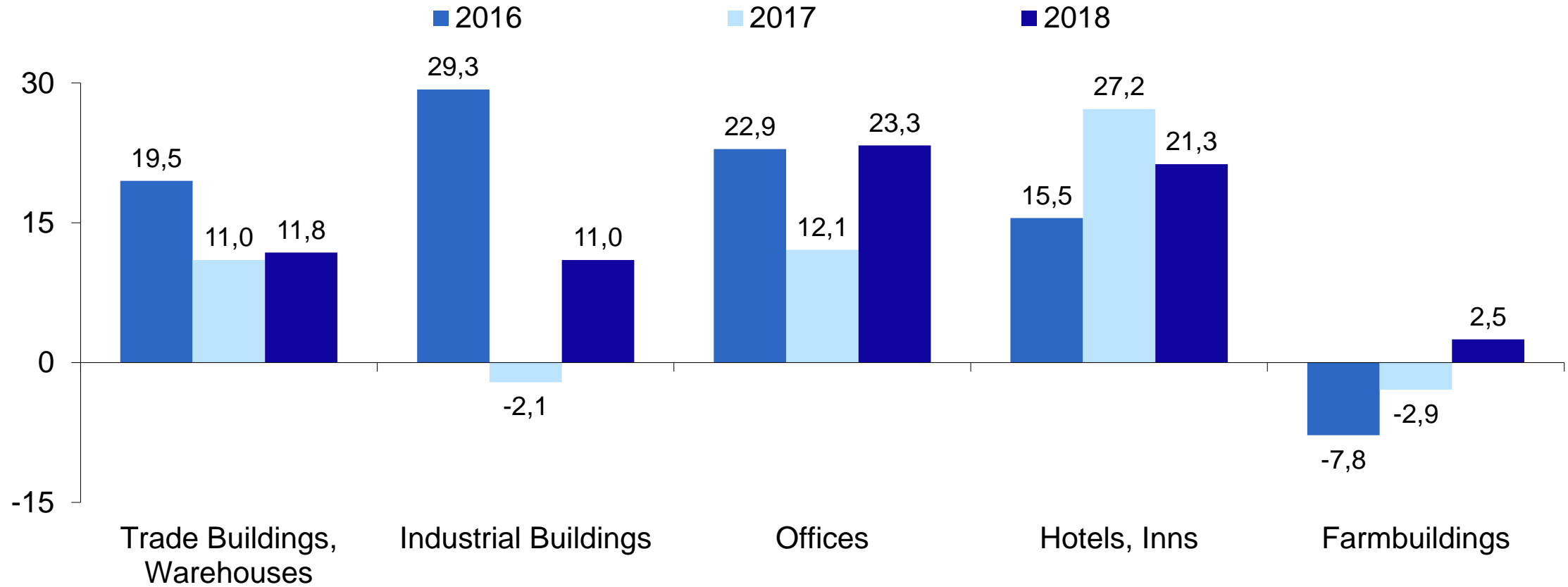
# Permits in Residential Construction
